Sunday Worship

9:30am every week

- 1st Sun of the month: Holy Communion
- 2nd Sun: The All Age/Family Service
- 3rd Sun: Holy Communion
- 4th Sun: Morning Worship
- 5th Sun: Holy Communion Together (here, St John's, Hope or Llanfynydd)

Our All Age Service on the 2nd Sunday

begins with bacon rolls at 9:30am ready for a 9:45am start. It is an informal service with story or drama and a short all age talk. The music group from St John's Penymynydd joins us and we sing more informal/contemporary songs as well as some of the hymn classics.



On the 3rd Sunday at 4pm (except July & August) is the increasingly popular **Messy Church** for families.

Midweek Activities

During the week there are several **popular** church activities for across the age ranges, including:

- **Coffee Morning**; every Tuesday 10:30-11:30am
